Cold water fish over one hundred pounds. Atlantic Salmon over sixty pounds. Truth, not fantasy, and this month's guest speaker has the photos to prove it. Gennadi Zarkhov will take CVFF "*Flyfishing in Russia.*"

With slides from the Kola Peninsula, near St. Petersburg, the Komi Republic in the Baltic, Crimea, the Caucasus, and Sakhalin Island, Mr Zharkov will cover flyfishing from one end of Asia to the other. He will share a historical perspective on what effect the political changes have had on sport fishing, as well as offer a feeling for the culture, traditions and the landscape of his native land.

Are Russia's streams and rivers polluted? Where is the Khoszu River? Are the salmon in Russia threatened or endangered? Where do you get a double taper seven weight floating line in a country with no fly fishing shops? What is the fishing pressure on the streams in the Arkhangelsk region? Is the Adams truly universal? As owner of the Henry's Fork Anglers, he has been an innovator of many spring creek patterns and western hair flies. Frequent contributor to fly fishing magazines and books, Mike has always been known as a "fly fisherman's fisherman", and has commanded respect among his peers. Formally a schoolteacher, Mike's fly fishing programs have made him popular on the fly fishing club circuit. His most recent accomplishments include the video tape "Tying Western Dry Flies" and "Learning to Fly Fish". As a defender of the trout, Mike has been called upon to champion the cause in front of TV cameras.

Jack Dennis



has written "The Western Trout Fly Tying Manual" Volume I and II, with over 300,000 in print, and has produced 7 fly fishing video tapes. Besides being involved in writing, Jack operates an art gallery, sporting goods store and a ski shop in Jackson Hole, Wyoming. Jack has been a guest on a variety of television shows, including ABC's "American Sportsman", "Fishing the West", the "Fishing Hole" and TV programs in Canada, Australia, New Zealand and Japan. Jack was a member of the Trout Unlimited Team in the first ever USSR-United States Angling Games, and was named to the U.S. Fly Fishing Team in the 9th annual World Fly Fishing Championships. Jack has journeyed throughout the world, both fishing and presenting fishing programs.
